Use the middle box to show which number is greater than ( $>$ ) or less than ( $<$ ) by writing in the sign.

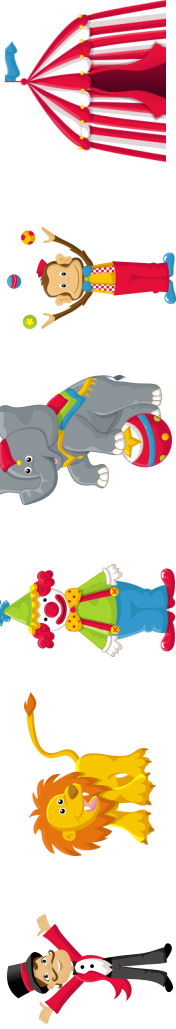


